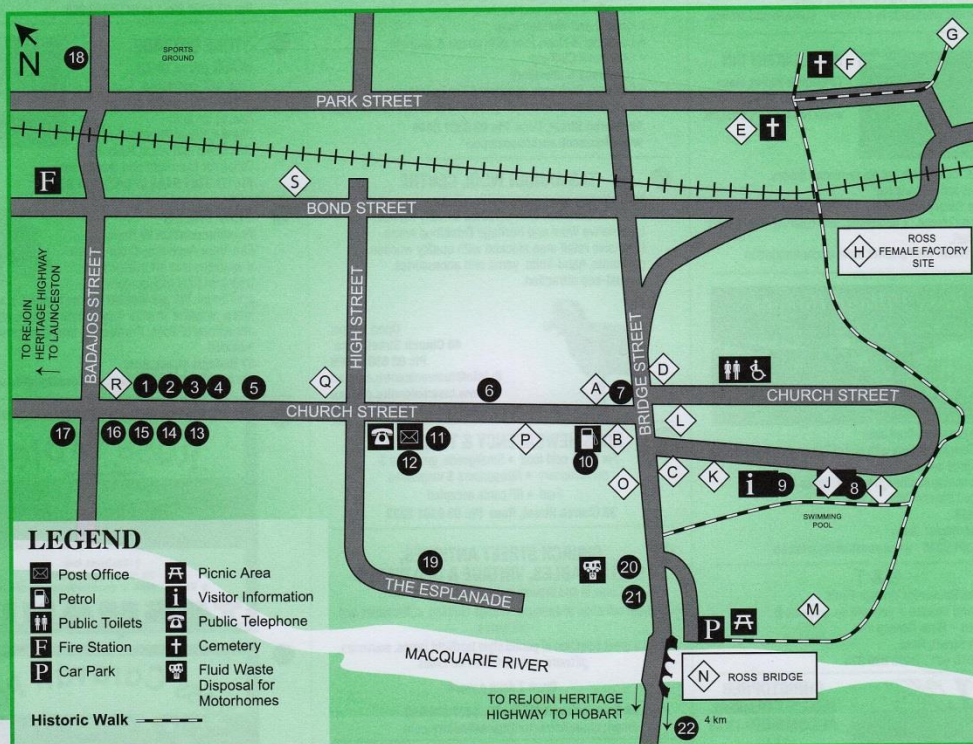

- C Damnation - Once the Town Gaol (Private residence)
- D Recreation - Town Hall (c1880)
- E Roman Catholic & Church of England Cemeteries
- F Original Burial Ground
- G Original Sandstone Quarry
- H Convict Female Factory site (c1848-1854)
- I Uniting Church (c1885)
- J Ross Drill Hall (c1900)
- K Original Headquarters - Army Ordnance Corps. (c1836)
- L War Memorial
- M Stables - Original Stables for military garrison horses
- N The Ross Bridge (1836)
- O The Barracks (c1827) (Private residence)
- P Scotch Thistle Inn (c1831) (Private residence)
- Q St John's Sunday School (c1847; rebuilt 1902)
- R St John's Church of England (1868)
